- Monitor the current position and image of Nes Ammim and maintain alignment with the target groups;
- Evaluate, create and/or update communication materials (internal/external, print & electronic);
- Responsible for the Nes Ammim websites and social network pages (Facebook, Instagram);
- Responsible for the content from Nes Ammim Israel, for the Dutch & German magazines and newsletters.



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Qualifications

- A bachelors or master's degree in communication or related fields
- Relevant experience in an international and inter-cultural context (preferably);
- Editorial experience;
- Strong communication skills, both verbally and written; excellent command of the English language;
- Ability to speak or willingness to learn basic Hebrew; Arabic (recommended).
- Full support of the mission, vision and Christian core values of Nes Ammim;
- Willingness to live in a small village community for a period of at least two years.
